

Drop-off / Sign-in Procedure

All children will sign into the Building facility when they arrive for church. All Volunteers for that week will greet children as they enter the building. They will then have the choice to eat breakfast or go into the Large Assembly Room and fellowship until 10:30. This is a good opportunity to interact with the children and talk with them.

Children are not allowed to play outside after they arrive due to supervision concerns. We are not adequately staffed or have marked boundaries to safely do so. On occasion a class may be required to go outside to perform a specific activity. In that case the teacher will be responsible and supervising his or her small group.

Children under 12 will need to be signed out by a parent or responsible adult.

*******NOTE – Under no circumstances will a child be allowed to leave the premises of their own will and on their own. All children are to remain inside the Building until released to a parent. Again under no circumstances will a child be allowed to go back and forth between 17 and 70 Bowling Lane. No exceptions. This is extremely important.**

Children who are unaccompanied minors living on Bowling Lane and walk to the facility will be required to get a signed Parents' Permission Slip to be kept on file. This will be renewable every school year. These children will sign themselves in when they arrive at the Building.

Dismissal for walkers will be as follows: At the end of the service, an Adult Volunteer will walk the children in a group from 70 Bowling Lane to 17 Bowling Lane, making sure the child gets safely to their house. If the child resides in the opposite direction towards the Basketball Court, a Volunteer will be assigned to assist them also.

Any children whose parents wish for them to walk to the Main Sanctuary at 17 Bowling Lane after the JF Kids! service ends will join the above group.
